

GRAND BEAR LODGE WATERPARK RULES

WAVE POOL

- Enter and exit the wave pool through the shallow end only.
- Stay clear of walls and safety ropes at the deep end of pool.
- Rafts or tubes are not allowed.
- No other flotation devices are allowed.
- No underwater diving or swimming while waves are on.
- Small and non-swimming children must swim with an adult.
- Swimming in waves can and will be physically tiring; pace yourself.

LAZY RIVER

- Enter and exit river only at designated areas.
- No climbing, sitting, standing or walking on the walls in the lazy river.
- No jumping or diving into the lazy river.
- Guests must use tubes/rafts supplied by the aquatic center at all times.
- No other flotation devices of any kind will be permitted.
- No diving, swimming or underwater swimming.
- No standing on tubes or stacking tubes.
- Floaters must follow the direction of the current at all times.
- Please do not block the progress of other users.
- Do not slow or stop the tubes on the river.

BODY & TUBE SLIDE

- Follow the instructions of the Attendant.
- No riders shorter than 48 inches.
- One rider on a single raft at a time.
- Remove goggles and any eyewear.
- Wearing any comb, bracelet, watch or other jewelry is prohibited.
- Feet first sliding only.
- No kneeling, standing, rotating or stopping in the slide.
- Diving or flipping while exiting the slide is prohibited.
- Catching sliders is not permissible. Sliders should be able to independently swim.
- Do not use the slide while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- DO NOT ride the slide if you have a physical ailment or condition, have neck or back problems, have high blood pressure, heart trouble, nervous disorder, or are pregnant.
- Exit slide recovery area immediately.

YELLOW KID'S SLIDE

- CAUTION: Water depth is 14 inches.
- Adults must use caution when using this slide.
- Riders must be in a sitting position with feet first.
- No standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling, or stopping.
- No tubes or rafts are permitted on this slide.
- Riders must be in good health; pregnant women or individuals with heart or back conditions should not use this slide.
- Exit slide recovery area immediately.

GENERAL RULES GRAND BEAR FALLS

- 1. All persons are encouraged to take a shower before entering the pool area.**
- 2. Parents or guardians must supervise their children at all times.**
- 3. All children who are not toilet trained shall wear swim diapers which are available for purchase in the Moose Crossing Convenience Store.**
- 4. No one should use the pool alone.**
- 5. No running or horseplay is allowed.**
- 6. No diving anywhere in the aquatic center.**
- 7. No food, beverage, or chewing gum is allowed in the water.**
- 8. No coolers or outside food and beverage are allowed in the aquatic center.**
- 9. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose or otherwise introducing contaminants into the water is prohibited.**
- 10. The pool water is not suitable for drinking. Avoid swallowing pool water.**
- 11. All swimwear worn in the pool shall be clean. No clothing other than swimwear and white T-shirts shall be worn in the pool. Swimsuits with buttons, zippers, rivets, or snaps on the back are not allowed. Thong bikinis are not allowed.**
- 12. All shoes or footwear, excluding aqua socks, are not allowed in the pool area or locker rooms.**
- 13. All children wearing Coast Guard life jackets must remain within arms reach of a swimming adult.**
- 14. Coast Guard approved life jackets that are labeled as such will be the only acceptable outside flotation device, unless an attraction restricts the use of the life jacket.**
- 15. Very small inflatables and swim toys will be allowed only at the indoor children's area.**
- 16. Only clean baby strollers or wheelchairs are allowed in the pool area or locker room.**
- 17. Glass, soap, sharp objects or other material which might create hazardous conditions or interfere with efficient operation of the swimming pool shall not be permitted in the water.**
- 18. Personal conduct within the pool facility must be such that the safety of self and others is not jeopardized.**
- 19. Always obey lifeguard instructions, posted warnings, guidelines and rules. Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing safety rules and responding to emergencies.**
- 20. In the case of inclement weather, management reserves the right to temporarily close the pool for the safety of all guests.**
- 21. Any person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the pool area.**
- 22. Admission to the pool shall be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, diarrhea, vomiting, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages, or other bandages of any kind shall be refused admittance.**
- 23. Management reserves the right to modify any and all rules as situations dictate. Failure to follow directions from pool staff will result in removal from the Aquatic Center.**
