

# Chaperone Policy

At Grizzly Jack's Grand Bear Resort, we strive to provide all guests with a GRAND experience while visiting our Resort. The safety and well being of our guests are first and foremost. To ensure this we have compiled a list of requirements for groups and organizations that include minors and young adults.

Ratio of Chaperones to Students shall be One (1) Chaperone to Six (6) Students under the age of Eighteen (18). Ratio of Chaperones to Students age Eighteen (18) and over shall be One (1) Chaperone to Ten (10) Students. Each Chaperone will be expected to complete a "Chaperone Registration Form" listing their contact information and the names of the students they will be responsible for.

Chaperones must be over the age of twenty-one (21), have a valid state issued picture identification card and a valid credit card for deposit, accommodations, expenses, etc. Students who are twenty-one (21) years of age and over, while visiting with a school group or organization will be subject to the guidelines that fall under the "Chaperone Policy": Chaperone's must refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages while providing supervision to the Students.

Deposit - All Villas and Cabins are privately owned. A deposit of \$1,000 per Villa and/or Cabin is required at the time of reservation until such time as the unit is inspected after departure. Upon verification that there are no missing items, and no damage or excessive clean-up is needed, the deposit will be refunded to you from the corporate office. Alternately, the costs for excessive clean-up, damage or missing items will be deducted from the deposit if necessary, and the remaining deposit, if any, will be refunded accordingly.

Respect - With the resort being a "family" destination, all students will be subject to all posted rules within the resort including our "Quiet Time" from 11pm - 8am. Upon all attractions closing, such as the indoor waterpark and indoor amusement park, students will be expected to retire to their room accommodations. Excessive "noise" or "complaints" from other guests will result in the students being asked to leave the resort property. Resort Security will be patrolling the property and students not abiding by our policy will be asked to checkout without a refund or compensation of any kind.

Parking - RV's and other large vehicles are prohibited from driving into the Villa and Cabin areas due to limited parking space and the inability to turn a large vehicle around. Vehicles such as limousines, buses, campers, etc. are asked to park in the Main Parking Lot. After checking in Students can be driven by the complimentary Resort Shuttle to their Villas and Cabins.

Smoke Free Property - There will be a separate deep cleaning and deodorizing fee incurred if there are apparent signs of smoking in any Villa and Cabin.

Drugs and Alcohol - The Resort prohibits the use of drugs and the consumption of alcohol by minors. Students will be asked to leave the property without refund or compensation if these rules are violated and the Resort will be report the incident to the local authorities.
